OVERVIEW AT THE PROJECT MAIN RESULTS:

[WP1] The **common report** on National Qualifications Framework/European Qualifications Framework and the Needs Analysis on the European Welding Practitioner Qualification **was delivered**. The survey highlighted skills gaps in the EWP profile, concerning tasks rated as increasing in importance for the welding community;

Major recommendations:

- To **enhance the alternative route of the EWP**, foreseeing the recognition of prior learning of every submodule;
- To **develop a matrix of Learning Outcomes for the EWP qualification**;
- To consider the **inclusion of work-based learning (apprenticeships) at the end of the whole qualification**, in order to enhance **technical skills and soft skills**;
- To consider the **inclusion of several hours of Technical English** at end of every submodule related to each subject;
- To consider the **inclusion of submodules of different subjects** (ie, visual inspection, welding economics, Welding Information and Communication Technologies and welding equipment maintenance).

ONGOING [WP2] The partners are currently working in the development of Learning Outcomes (LOs) for the European Welding Practitioner and the pedagogical kit for trainers is being drafted.

ONGOING [WP3] Sectoral organisation - ISQ, MHE, NTIM and CESOL - are progressively working in EWF Qualification competence Matrix, thus by making the alignment between EU tools (EQF & ECVET) and the EWP qualification.

ONGOING [WP6] Dissemination has been a constant effort during this months. Examples of these are the project's flyer and poster, now available in all consortium languages (EN, PT, ES, HU, NO)

UPCOMING [WP4] The objective of this work package is the development of a harmonised RPL scheme for welding sector, in order to certify the informal and non-formal learning in this area. This WP also includes the development of diagnosis tools to assess the informal and non-formal learning; the development of a guideline as well as the drawing of the certification process and possible pathways.

UPCOMING [WP5] EWP LOs Standard and RPL tools will be implemented through national piloting events, in order to test the adequacy and feasibility of the developed materials.
